The Co-Editors of the [Māori Law Review](#) want to appoint a **Student Editor** for 2020 to assist with producing the Review.

This is an opportunity to work with a committed team of authors with expertise in legal issues affecting Māori.

The student editor's tasks will include:

- Coordinating with the editorial team the articles to be published each month;
- Assisting in the coordination of MLR events;
- Assisting with the production of a digest of Māori Land Court decisions;
- Assisting with the Review's social media presence; and
- Attendance at fortnightly editorial meetings with the Co-editors.

The student editor would be expected to work an average of 6 hours per week over 40 weeks, starting in March 2020.

This is an unpaid role but one with significant opportunities for a person interested in working in this area of the law. The Review's former student editors are an impressive group of alumni.

The Student Editor will have the use of a shared office in the law faculty at Victoria University of Wellington.
